#### **HOA Facts**

Did you know that more than 63 million people are residents of communities with a homeowners association? That means 24 percent of U.S. homes are in community associations.

Residents of HOA-regulated communities typically associate their style of living with positive camaraderie for the betterment of the community as a whole. Here are some compiled statistics and facts to prove it:

- There are almost 310,000 HOA-governed communities in the United States. (That's a 260 percent growth since their inception in the 1970s).
- 92 percent of residents "rate their community association experience as positive (70 percent) or neutral (22 percent)."
- 90 percent of people say that they're on good terms with their board members.
- 76 percent of people say that their association rules and regulations "protect and enhance property values."
- 88 percent of residents say "their elected governing boards strive to serve the best interests of the community."
- More than 8,000 new community associations are formed annually.
- Committee members perform almost 10 million hours of community service annually. That's about \$1.6 billion of service provided.
- Washington State ranks in the top 10 for the highest value of association board and committee time.\*

## Manager's Corner - David Franklin

**Storage Lot Update** – The Storage Lot Refurbishment Project is moving ahead as scheduled thanks to the efforts of Community Members and our hard driving Project Manager Ric Henderson. Contractors have been awarded bids and the completion date is still projected to be October 1<sup>st</sup>, 2018. The new plans are available in the office or call and we can email them to you. Expect the following:

- New Rates To be determined in August by a Board Subcommittee.
- New Leases New leases will be available September 1<sup>st</sup>, 2018. No spaces will be assigned before this date. Those Members with previous Storage Lot Leases will be given priority on a first come first serve basis. There will be close to twice the number of spaces available with power.
- Security Access control fobs will allow members to open the new automatic gate. No more keys! There will be improved lighting, security cameras and Wi-Fi allowing members to monitor their property with their own security systems.

**C** Dock Replacement Project – C Dock is on schedule to be replaced and if you have a vessel on C Dock or are just curious, this is what you need to know:

- **Project Timing** Depending on weather the old C Dock should be empty and ready for demolition on November 1<sup>st</sup>. The new C Dock will be moved in and utilities connected within two weeks. All boats should be back in their slips or have found new slips in the Marina by December 1<sup>st</sup>.
- **Temporary Moorage** Shelter Bay will try to accommodate boats from C Dock on other docks within the Marina. Some boats will be moved permanently due to configuration changes. A few boats might need to be placed on private docks or moved to the La Conner Marina until the project is complete.

**Dead Trees in Shelter Bay** – The Greenbelt Committee has collected bids for the removal of dead trees along Shelter Bay Drive. The Committee will make recommendations to the Board for a contract award in August. Work should begin in September and completed in October. #### **Pool Season Updates** – News from the Pool:

• **Recent Lower Pool Closures** – Twice in the same week the Lower Pool was closed due to children vomiting into the pool. The Washington State Department of Health requires the pool be closed for 24hrs after such incidents or the Community could be faced with a fine. Please make sure children are properly hydrated and that they have adequate supervision. Please be aware that ensuring adherence to State Law and Community Rules are the primary function of the Pool Attendants. They are not meant to be Life Guards or to watch Member's children. No children under 10 years old should be left at the pool without a guardian.

#### Payment Systems – Things you should be aware of:

- Online Bill Payment Systems- Please be aware that when you pay with online bill pay from your bank's website, it takes 7-10 business days for that payment to make it to Shelter Bay. Many people assume that these payments are electronic and instantaneous, and they are angered when they receive a late payment notice from Shelter Bay. Most of these systems generate a check that has to be mailed the same as you would do from home, only slower.
- Payment Portal The Manager is working with our new software providers to complete the transition of the Marina from the Company into the Community. Once completed the new payment system will be available to Members and Marina tenants.

## Arborist Site Visit—Dead Trees

The following excerpts were taken from the arborist site visit report submitted to the Greenbelt/Lot Committee by Al Craney, CF, District Forester, Skagit Conservation District:

- The trees are under extreme moisture stress because of the soil type (gravelly, loamy sand) on the sites visited.
- The effects go back to the drought of 2015, as we found trees dying going back 3 years. Trees were found dead in 2016 (2015 drought), 2017 (2016 drought), and current dying trees 2018 (2017 drought).
- The stressed trees are an ideal environment for bark beetles to establish and they have increased in number each year. Trees most affected are grand fir, western red cedar, and some Douglas-fir. I believe the type of bark beetle is the Fir Engraver Beetle, (Scolytus ventralis), but you may have more than one type of beetle. Fir engraver activity is strongly associated with drought, when trees are in a weakened condition. An investigation by a forest entomologist would be helpful.
- Other disease conditions were identified and play into the forest health equation.
- Bottom line is a number of factors are leading to decreased tree health and are anticipated to continue without careful intervention.
- Additional note: black cottonwood, (Populus trichocarpa), is not a good species to have around structures as a safety factor. Firewise trees should be considered if replacement is done.
