Absences

If you are away from Shelter Bay for a length of time, you may contact the Swinomish Tribal Police if you are interested in having them perform periodic property checks while you are gone. It is also important to provide Shelter Bay with a contact number that can be reached when you are away in case of emergencies. This information can be provided in your account when you set it up.

Library

A community library of donated reading materials for Shelter Bay residents is located in the Community Annex, located across from the marina restrooms at 1001 Shelter Bay Drive. The Annex also has a small meeting room available for member to rent for meetings up of 8-10 people.

Marina

Shelter Bay Marina has over 200 slips for rent and provides a 10% discount to residents. The marina has been completely rebuilt with new docks over the past few years with the most recent upgrades in the South Basin in 2022. Marina tenants enjoy the amenities of Shelter Bay such as the BBQ Pavilion, tennis courts, and pickleball courts. Live-a-boards are allowed (see rules for details). There is a boat ramp, pump out station, marina restrooms with showers and a full-time harbormaster.

RV Storage Lot

Shelter Bay's Rules & Regulations do not allow for parking of RVs, campers, boats, or trailers on lots and therefore is happy to provide space in the RV Storage Lot, located at the entrance. The facility is accessible 24/7, fully fenced, gated, and has security cameras.
